41 attended the Global Study Program

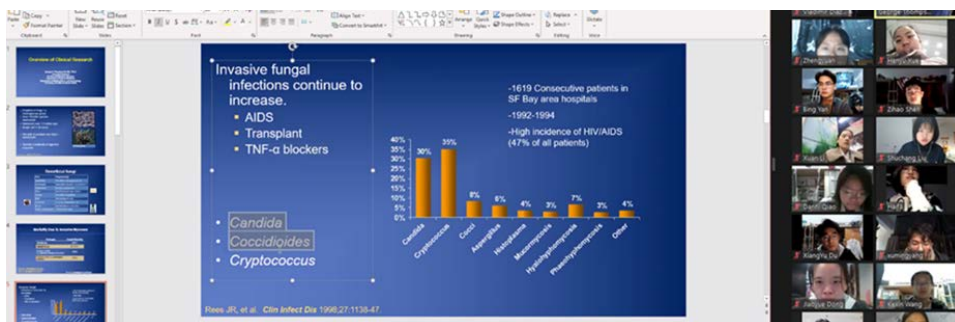

Research Methodology Course in STEM offered in 2020-2021 for the First Time



UC Davis International Program's new online course *Research Methodology and Graduate Preparation in STEM* provides international undergraduates with an opportunity to learn about research from a Tier 1 U.S. research institution without leaving their home country. Led by UC Davis faculty, this online course focuses on introducing students to the culture of science in academia and connecting them with leaders in the fields of science, engineering, math and technology. The course curriculum includes:

- Lectures from leading faculty at UC Davis about their research career
- Tutoring for preparation of science research presentations
- Science Writing seminars
- Visit to a UC Davis research facility

During the 2020-2021 academic year, 130 students attended these virtual courses. Students attended classes from five distinct universities: Henan University School of Medicine, Tsinghua University, East China Normal University, South China University of Technology Department of Chemistry and Nanjing Agricultural Institution. They studied in a variety of fields including medicine, engineering, epidemiology and chemistry.

The course was well received with a 100% satisfaction rate. Student reflection essays regarding their overall experience in the course have been very positive. A coordinator from East China Normal University (ECNU) reported that most students have "gained a lot in this course," and that "ECNU is very satisfied with the outcome." The benefits of the course can also be seen in the feedback we received from the students:
